Day 1: Sunday, April 11, 2027 Overnight Flight Feel the vibrant energy of England, hear the unique sounds of Scotland, and see the rolling countryside of Wales on a trip that combines dramatic history and an array of fascinating landscapes.

Day 2: Monday, April 12, 2027 Edinburgh, Scotland Arrive in Edinburgh, the historic capital of Scotland, where rocky hills, towers in the distance, and the shadows of history can be seen around every corner. With no scheduled sightseeing today in consideration of varied arrival times, take some time to discover Scotland's capital for yourself and see how medieval crossroads blend seamlessly with a vibrant modern energy. This evening, join your fellow travelers for a welcome dinner. (D)

Day 3: Tuesday, April 13, 2027 Edinburgh Start the day with a panoramic and walking tour of old and new Edinburgh, exploring Georgian architecture, writers and monuments, alleyways and hidden passages, and the dark and mysterious side of the city. Then, walk up the Royal Mile to enter Edinburgh Castle, home to the Scottish Crown Jewels. After a guided tour of the castle grounds, enjoy time to explore the city as you wish this afternoon and evening. Perhaps you will choose to join an optional night of Scottish food, song, and dance. (B)

Day 4: Wednesday, April 14, 2027 Edinburgh - York, England Say goodbye to the rolling hills of Scotland while traveling south on a local passenger train to York. After you arrive, join a walk to get familiar with York's streets before taking some free time to enjoy lunch on your own. After an afternoon visit to the magnificent York Minster, the rest of the day is yours to explore independently. This evening, you may wish to join an optional tour to a family-run Yorkshire vineyard and sample a selection of English wines over a traditional home-cooked dinner. (B)

Day 5: Thursday, April 15, 2027 York - Chester This morning, travel to Chester, your home for the next two nights, where ancient walls enclose charming Tudor and Victorian houses. Discover the charms of the city with your local guide before taking some time for lunch. This afternoon, **it's your choice!** Enjoy a guided tour of the magnificent Chester Cathedral **-OR-** take a leisurely boat ride along the tranquil River Dee. (B, D)

Day 6: Friday, April 16, 2027 Chester - Conwy, Wales - Llangollen - Chester, England Today, venture to the inviting town of Conwy in Wales. Visit Conwy Castle to discover the history behind one of Edward I's most imposing castles and take a leisurely stroll around town, seeking out local shops, cafés, and markets. Then take a scenic drive to the picturesque town of Llangollen. Stand on the bridge to watch the fast-flowing waters beneath and take in the hustle and bustle of this charming, popular town. (B)

Day 7: Saturday, April 17, 2027 Chester - Stratford-upon-Avon Step back in time on a journey through the English countryside to Stratford-upon-Avon — the Bard's birthplace. Join for a walk through the town's busy streets and then sit down to a traditional English afternoon tea. Tour the childhood home of William Shakespeare, and take time to explore this historic market town on your own. (B, L)

Day 8: Sunday, April 18, 2027 Stratford-upon-Avon - London Bid farewell to Stratford and travel to the esteemed capital - London. Upon arriving in the bustling Covent Garden area, take some time and have lunch on your own. Then, join a local guide for a three-hour walking tour, taking in the iconic landmarks of Westminster from the outside, including Big Ben, the Houses of Parliament, Westminster Abbey, and Buckingham Palace. Later, settle in at your hotel and spend the evening in the city as you wish. (B)

Day 9: Monday, April 19, 2027 London Take in London your way today with a full day at leisure. Or, you may wish to join an optional tour to Windsor Castle, the majestic residence that has been the home of British royalty for centuries, offering a glimpse into the lives of monarchs past and present. (B, D)

Day 10: Tuesday, April 20, 2027 London - Tour Ends Your journey through Britain comes to a close today. (B)

The overall activity level of this tour is a level 2. This means you like a balanced approach to travel. Walking two to three miles over the course of a day is no problem for you. You can handle a variety of terrains, from cobblestone streets to moderate hills with relative ease and without assistance. You can climb two flights of stairs with ease. Expect some full days balanced with free time to recharge or set out on your own adventure. You can handle altitudes up to 6,000 feet. While this level is appropriate for travelers that require mobility assistance devices, there could be times when you may have to sit out on some of the included activities.

Experience It! Conwy, Wales

One of the loveliest towns to explore on the northern coast of Wales is Conwy (from Old Welsh *cyn* "chief" and *gwy* "water"). Originally an English military outpost built in the 13th century, it retains beautifully preserved medieval walls as well as the towering fortress known as Conwy Castle, with eight lofty towers complete with spiral staircases. This mighty monument, standing high above the small town and the riverbank, was built, amazingly, in just four years by the English King Edward I and his architect. UNESCO has designated the castle a World Heritage Site, noted as one of the finest examples of late 13th- and early 14th-century military architecture in Europe. Stretching across from the castle lie the town, the river, and the craggy mountains of Snowdonia. The town itself, notable for its scenic harbor front, is dotted with quaint cafés, tearooms, and markets that beckon travelers.

Travel with an average of 37 people (maximum of 44).

The city tour of London is on foot and requires walking up to 3 miles over 3 hours.

Due to tour scheduling, arrival flights should arrive prior to 4:00 p.m.

Prepaid tipping is not available on our tours therefore payment of customary end-of-trip gratuities for your Tour Manager, driver, local guides, hotel housekeepers, and cruise ship waitstaff should be handled individually when applicable during the course of your tour.

Economy air rate and schedule are applicable for groups of 10 or more traveling on the same flights and dates.

Travel Requirements:

Passports are required for this tour at your expense. Certain countries require that your passport be valid at least 6 months beyond the dates of your travel.
